### **POLICE OFFICER AWARD**

- 1. Conduct which demonstrates an understanding of the Constitution and especially the Bill of Rights;
- 2. Conduct which encourages respect for the law and the rule of law;
- 3. Conduct which promotes and contributes to a better understanding of, respect for, and effective functioning of the judicial process;
- 4. Cooperation with the legal community; and
- 5. Conduct which demonstrates a concern for society and appreciation for the dignity of all persons.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any law enforcement officer of any law enforcement agency whose jurisdiction includes or encompasses any part of Erie County.

<u>CANDIDATE SELECTION:</u> Nominations shall be made by the Criminal Law Committee. The Criminal Law Committee shall then recommend a recipient to the Board of Directors. A majority vote of the Board of Directors shall be required for approval.
