## FREE LEGAL ASSISTANCE UNCONTESTED DIVORCES

To honor the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., the New York State Unified Court System - Civic Engagement, the Franklin H. Williams Judicial Commission, the Erie Supreme and County Court, and the University of Buffalo School of Law will host a day of service to promote civic engagement and volunteerism in the community. On **Monday, January 27, 2025**, volunteer law students from the University of Buffalo School of Law will be available to assist court users to commence an uncontested divorce case.

**This program is limited to individuals commencing an uncontested divorce case. Participants will have the opportunity to receive assistance in completing the necessary forms for uncontested divorces. Please note that this legal assistance is exclusively for uncontested divorces that DO NOT involve children or property.**

- Appointments are mandatory, and participants must pre-register to ensure they receive the assistance they require. Availability is limited and will operate on a first-come, first-served basis. Walk-ins will not be accepted.
- All participants are required to present photo identification and provide the full names, addresses, dates of birth, places of birth, and SSN (if applicable) for both parties.
- A filing fee of \$210 is required to commence a divorce action. If you are seeking a waiver for the filing fee, income documentation will be necessary.
